NOTIFICATION

Imphal, the 17th March, 2023

No. 1/6/2022-RR(Home)/DP(Pt): In supersession of all previous rules issued in this regard and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Manipur hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of **Inspector of Police (Civil)** in the Police Department, Manipur as shown in the M.P.S.C. Form-8, namely:-

- 1. **Short title:**-These rules may be called the Police Department, Manipur [Inspector of Police (Civil)] Recruitment Rules, 2023.
- 2. **Application:-** These rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the M.P.S.C. Form-8 hereto annexed.
- 3. **Classification, Scale of pay, method of recruitment etc.:-** Classification of the said post, scale of pay, method of recruitment and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in the columns 3 to 13 of the said MPSC Form-8.

4. **Disqualifications:-**

- (a) No person, who has more than one wife living or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reason of its taking place during the life time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment to the aforesaid post, and
- (b) No woman, whose marriage is void by reason of the husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the time of such marriage, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor of Manipur may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. "Power to relax- Where the Governor is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may order for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Manipur Public Service Commission, for relaxation of any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts."
- 6. These rules shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Manipur Gazette.

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF INSPECTOR OF POLICE (CIVIL)

1.	Designation of post(s)	Inspector of Police (Civil)
2.	No. of post(s)	All posts of Inspector of Police (Civil) in the Police Department
3.	Classification	G.C.S. Class-I/Group-A (Non-Ministerial) Non-Gazetted
4.	Scale of Pay	Level-9 (Rs. 43,300 to 1,37,100/-) in the pay matrix of Manipur Service (Revised Pay Rules, 2019)
5.	Whether selection post or non-selection post	Selection post
6.	Age for direct recruit	N.A.
7.	Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits	N.A.
8.	Whether age and educational qualification prescribed for the direct recruits will apply in the case of promotes	N.A.
9.	Period of probation, if any	2 (two) years
10.	Method of reccruitment whether by direct recruit or by promotion or by deputation/ transfer & percentage of the sanctioned post to be filled by various method.	By promotion
11.	In case of recruitment by promotion/deputation/transfer, grades from which promotion/deputation/transfer to be made.	PROMOTION Eligibility for Promotion: HSSLC/XII or its equivalent Sub-Inspectors of Police who have passed the Departmental Examination conducted by the MPSC and completed 5 (five) years regular service in the grade. Provided that not more than 10% of the vacancies arising in a recruitment year may be filled from HSSLC/XII or its equivalent Sub-Inspectors of Police who have passed the Departmental Examination conducted by the MPSC and completed

		3 (three) years regular service in the grade and who have been recommended by the Director General of Police for promotion by reason of their extraordinary performance in discharge of official duties or who are outstanding sports persons recognized by the All India Police Sports Control Board irrespective of their rank/position in the seniority list. Methodology of marking for selection shall be based on Rule C of DGP's Standing order No. 189 and it's amendment from time to time. Candidate(s) shall be recommended and ranked for out of turn promotion based on the consolidated/total marks achieved as per the above methodology. Provided that Officer recommended beyond the normal zone of consideration under such category shall be placed below the officer recommended under normal zone of consideration in the merit list.
12.	If a DPC exists, what is its composition.	Class-I D.P.C.
13.	Circumstances in which MPSC is to be consulted in making recruitment.	As required under MPSC (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1972.
