NOTIFICATION

Imphal, the 27th January, 2025

No.RRDP-19/1/2024-DP-DP: In exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to clause (3) of Article 320 of the Constitution of India, read with the decision of the State Cabinet in its sitting held on 10.10.2024 and 22.01.2025, the Governor of Manipur hereby makes the following regulation to further amend the Manipur Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1972, namely:

1. SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:

- i. These regulations may be called the Manipur Public Service Commission (Exemption from consultation) (Amendment) Regulations, 2025.
- ii. They shall come into force from the date of issue of this Notification.

2. Addition of Regulation 136 – After Regulation 135 of the Manipur Public Service Commission (Exemption from Consultation) Regulations, 1972, the following regulation shall be added, namely:

"136 – It shall not be necessary to consult the Commission (MPSC) with regard to the one-time relaxation of Manipur Civil Engineering (PWD) Service Rules, 2016, as amended from time to time, for promotion to Chief Engineer (Water Resources), Manipur as mentioned below:
