No. 2/9/2023-Leg/L: The following Act of the Legislature, Manipur which received assent of the Governor of Manipur on March 18, 2023 is hereby published in the Official Gazette:

THE DHANAMANJURI UNIVERSITY (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2023 (MANIPUR ACT NO. 7 OF 2023)

further to amend the Dhanamanjuri University Act, 2017 (Manipur Act No. 9 of 2017).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Manipur in the Seventy-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Dhanamanjuri University (Amendment) Act, 2023.
- Short title and commencement.
- (2) It shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. In section 14 of the Dhanamanjuri University Act, 2017 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act),-
- Amendment of section 14.
- (i) in the second proviso to sub-section (2), for the words "of 3(three) years", the words "not exceeding 3(three) years" shall be substituted.
- (ii) in sub-section (4), for the words "of five years", the words "not exceeding five years" shall be substituted.
- (iii) in the proviso to sub-section (4), for the words "the Vice-Chancellor shall", the words "with the approval of the Chancellor, the Vice-Chancellor may" shall be substituted.
- (iv) after sub-section (4), the following new sub-section (5) shall be inserted, namely,-

- "(5) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Act and the Statutes, the Administrative Secretary in-charge of the Department of Higher & Technical Education shall be exofficio Vice-Chancellor, if for any reason, the posts of the Vice-Chancellor and the Pro Vice-Chancellor remain vacant."
- **3.** In the Second Schedule to the Principal Act, proviso to para 2(iii) shall be deleted.
