Subject :- Decision of the Government relating to grant of Dearness Allowance to the State Government employees.

No: 2/6/2010-FD(PIC): The undersigned is directed to say that consequent upon the introduction of Manipur Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2010, the Governor of Manipur is pleased to order that the following rates of Dearness Allowance shall be admissible to all categories of State Government employees with effect from 01/04/2010:-

Date of Effect	Rate of Dearness Allowance
01/01/2006	No Dearness Allowance
01/07/2006	2 % of basic pay
01/01/2007	6 % of basic pay
01/07/2007	9 % of basic pay
01/01/2008	12 % of basic pay
01/07/2008	16 % of basic pay
01/01/2009	22 % of basic pay
01/07/2009	27 % of basic pay
01/01/2010	35 % of basic pay

- 2. The term 'basic pay' in the revised pay structure means the pay drawn in the prescribed Pay Band plus the applicable Grade Pay but does not include any other type of pay like special pay, etc. For the purpose of calculation of Dearness Allowance, Non-Practising Allowance, where applicable, shall be taken into account as at present.
- 3. The Dearness Allowance will continue to be a distinct element of remuneration and will not be treated as pay within the ambit of FR 9(21).
- 4. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fractions of 50 paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and the fractions of leas than 50 paise may be ignored.
