NOTIFICATION Imphal, the 31st August, 2010

No. 1/151/81(RR)/DP(Pt.-I): In supersession of all previous rules issued in this regard and in exercise of the powers conferred by the Proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Manipur hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Manager of Publication in the Department of Information and Public Relations(DIPR), Manipur as shown in the M.P.S.C. Form-8, namely:

- 1. Short title:- These rules may be called the Department of Information and Public Relations(DIPR), Manipur MANAGER OF PUBLICATION Recruitment Rules, 2010.
- 2. Application:-These rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the M.P.S.C. Form-8 hereto annexed.
- 3. Classification, Scale of pay, method of recruitment etc. :- Classification of the said post, scale of pay, method of recruitment and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in the columns 3 to 13 of the said MPSC Form-8.

4. Disqualifications:-

- (a) No person, who has more than one wife living or who having a spouse living, marries in any case in which such marriage is void by reason of its taking place during the life time of such spouse, shall be eligible for appointment to the aforesaid post, and
- (b) No woman, whose marriage is void by reason of the husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the time of such marriage, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.

Provided that the Governor of Manipur may, if satisfied that there are special grounds for so ordering, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. "Power to relax Where the Governor is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Manipur Public Service Commission, for relaxation of any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts."
- 6. These rules shall come into force with effect from the date of publication in the Manipur Gazette.

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF MANAGER OF PUBLICATION IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION AND PUBLIC RELATIONS, MANIPUR.

1.	Designation of post:	Manager of Publication
2.	No. of post:	1(one).
3.	Classification:	GCS Class-II(gazetted)
4.	Scale of pay:	Rs. 5,500-175-9,000/-p.m.
		[As per MS(RP) Rules, 1999]
5.	Whether selection or non selection post:	Selection.
6.	Age for direct recruits:	N.A.
7.	Educational and other qualification required for direct recruits:	N.A.
8.	Whether age & educational qualification prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees:	N.A.
9.	Period of probation, if any:	2(two) years.
10.	Method of recruitment whether by direct recruit or by promotion or by deputation/ transfer and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods:	By promotion
11.	In case of recruitment by promotion/ deputation/transfer grades from which promotion/ deputation/ transfer to be made:	i) Stenographers Grade-I of the Information & Public Relations Department, Manipur with 5 (five) years regular service and trained at least in Management Course of a recognised Institute/ Firm. ii) Translator/ Journalist/ Reporter/ Information Assistant/ News Scanner/ Announcer with 5(five) years regular service in their respective grades.
12.	If a DPC exists what is its compositions:	Class-II D.P.C.
13.	Circumstances in which MPSC is to be consulted in making recruitment:	As required under the MPSC (Exemption from consultation) Regulations, 1972.

Note:-

- 1. The promotees should fulfill the condition of qualifying service for promotion on the date on which the proposal is sent to the Commission provided that where a person is considered for such appointment all persons who are senior to him in the grade shall also be considered irrespective of the fact whether or not they fulfill the requirement as to the minimum period of qualifying service for purpose of promotion mentioned above.
- 2. Any period of ad-hoc appointment prior to appointment on regular basis in consultation with the Commission shall not be counted towards the minimum period of service prescribed for promotion.
