## **OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Imphal, the 22nd November, 2012

Subject: Revision of provisions regulating pension/gratuity/commutation of pension/

family pension of pre/post 01-01-2006 pensioners/family pensioners of

Manipur Judicial Officers: Clarifications thereof.

No. 15/9/2005-Case/PC(Law): The undersigned is directed to say that the revision of provisions regulating pension/gratuity/Commutation of pension/Family pension of pre/post 01-01-2006 pensioners/ Family pensioners of Manipur made vide this Govt. Office Memo No. 15/9/2005-Case/PC (Law) dated 22-3-2012 has been re-examined in pursuance of letter No. Pen/7Policy/R&Pay Pen Rules/MJS/ 2012/143 dated 18-6-2012 and the Governor of Manipur is pleased to make the following clarifications to the paragraphs contained in Office Memo No. 15/9/2005-Case/PC(Law) Dated 22nd March, 2012 as follows:

1. Para No. 3.3 of O.M. No. 15/9/2005-Case/PC(Law) dated 22nd March, 2012 shall be read as under:

"Linkage of full pension with 33 years of qualifying service shall be dispensed with. In case where a judicial Officer of the Manipur Judicial Services who has retired/superannuated after completion of 20 years of qualifying service but before completion of 10 years of qualifying service in accordance with Rule 49(2) of the MCS (Pension) Rules, 1977, pension in those cases shall be paid at 50% of the last pay drawn or 50% of average emoluments drawn during 10 months preceding the date of superannuation, whichever is more beneficial to the member."

2. Para No. 3.5 of O.M. No. 15/9/2005-Case/PC(Law) dated 22nd March, 2012 shall be read as under:

"The Manipur Civil Services (Commutation of pension) Rules, 2010 which came into force w.e.f. 01-01-2006 in the State of Manipur shall also apply to the Judicial Officers of the State Government who retired on or after 01-01-2006. Commutation of Pension in respect of the retired Judicial Officers shall be 50% of the basic pension."

3. After para No. 3.6 of the above O.M. the following sub para shall be inserted:

"The enhanced family pension admissible under Rule 54(3)(a)(i) of the MCS(Pension) Rules, 1977 shall also be payable to the family of a Judicial Officer who dies in service on or after 01-01-2006 from the date following the date of death of the Judicial Officer for a period of 10 years without any upper age limit. There will be no change in the period for payment of enhanced family pension to the family in case of death of a pensioner as provided under Rule 54(3)(a)(i), ibid."

- 4. A separate para as 4.2 shall be added after existing para 4.1 of the above O.M. as follows:
- "4.2. Payment of arrears of pension and other retirement/death benefits in respect of the Judicial Officers who retired/expired on or after 01-01-2006 shall be made in cash from the date following the date of retirement or death, as the case may be."

This issues in consultation with the Finance Department and the Law Department, Government of Manipur.
